



COVID-19 RULES AND GOLF GUIDELINE FOR RIVENDELL GOLF CLUB

Golf Operations

- Please do not show up more than (20) minutes prior to your tee time
- The first tee time will be 8:00AM and the last tee time will be 6:00PM
- Nine (9) minute tee time intervals
- Tee times will be booked through our online system or by calling the Pro Shop. No booking tee times in the pro shop.
- Putting Green will be available fifteen (15) minutes prior to tee time
- Golfers are asked to be in the first tee area no longer than five (5) minutes prior to their tee time
- Club owned push carts will be available and disinfected after each use.
- A drop area location will be available after your round to drop off your power cart key, cooler bag and club owned push cart to be disinfected for the next golfers.
- Power carts will be available. One (1) rider permitted per power cart, unless they have driven to the golf club together or the same household. Each golf cart will be sprayed after each use with our STER-SAN PV RTU Covid-19 disinfecter
- After play, golfers should go directly to their carts and park them in designated areas
- Towels will not be available for use
- Club Storage/Personal push cart storage will be unavailable
- The lockers will not be accessible
- The washrooms in the clubhouse will be closed. You may access the washrooms on the patio (two people at a time) or on the course (one person only). They will be disinfected regularly
- The pro shop will be accepting all methods of payment (cash included). Please read the sign on the door and follow the instructions. Two (2) people at a time.
- Our Handicap computer will be out of use. If you would like to enter a score please ask the pro shop.
- No drinking water station available in the clubhouse. No refill on personal use water bottles/coffee cups



On Course

- It is **MANDATORY** that Flag sticks remain in the hole at all times
- Cups will have a noodle in them in a manner that prevents the ball from hitting the bottom of the hole. The ball can be removed without human contact with the flagstick
- Continuous putting is encouraged
- All benches will be removed
- Ball Washers will be unavailable
- Please "foot rake" all bunkers as best you can. Any "unraked" areas of bunkers will be deemed an Abnormal Ground Condition and free relief within the bunker will be allowed
- A group catching up to the group ahead of them will be asked to keep their distance to minimize interaction on tee decks. Groups will only be permitted to play through with the assistance of our staff to ensure that physical distancing rules are being respected.
- Our marshals will monitor the golf course to ensure that all measures are being adhered to.
- Please replace divots and repair ball markers.
- When using a riding cart as a single rider, under no circumstances are you to provide a walker with a ride
- Please leave found balls where they lie
- Food and beverage - limited menu in the kitchen. You may enter through the west side doors (facing the ninth green). Please follow instructions on the door. Two (2) people at a time permitted
- Threatening weather - we ask players to shelter in their vehicles. Play may not be allowed during threat of bad weather

We at Rivendell appreciate and expect your cooperation to allow us to open the course to play. Everyone has managed to play by the rules of golf and now we are asking that you obey our rules of COVID-19 golf. Any failure to comply with our rules may result in disciplinary action by the Club including loss of golfing privileges.
